CONSIDER APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE PREVIOUS MEETING:

DISCUSS AND CONSIDER RECOMMENDING APPROVAL OF ORDINANCE PROHIBITING TOBACCO USE AT ALL CITY PARKS EXCEPT MUNICIPAL GOLF COURSE, SAHOMA LAKE, AND PRETTY WATER LAKE PROPERTIES:

According to City Manager Joan Riley, the ordinance prohibiting tobacco use at city parks, except for the golf course, Sahoma Lake and Pretty Water Lake, is on the agenda for the city council to consider. Someone did reach out to the students who were at the last council meeting to advise them the council will be reconsidering the tobacco ordinance.

DISCUSS AND CONSIDER FINANCING ALTERNATIVES FOR THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT NEEDS AT THE CITY GOLF COURSE:

City Manager Joan Riley told the committee the municipal golf course is in need of a new irrigation system, Wi-Fi service, and improvements to the clubhouse. The irrigation system is not working correctly, requiring it to be manually turned on. The city does not have the funding to make the necessary capital improvements at this time.

Carla Stinnett suggested the rebranding of the golf course to take advantage of the Route 66 market. She also recommended outsourcing the operation of the grill to a restaurant, and a capital fund raising campaign for the golf course improvements.

No action was taken by the committee.

DISCUSS AND CONSIDER RECOMMENDING APPROVAL OF ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SAPULPA CITY CODE, PART 4, ANIMALS, TO PROVIDE FOR EXCEPTION TO THE RESTRICTION ON POSSESSING SWINE WITHIN CITY LIMITS:

Motion was made by Craig Henderson, seconded by Hugo Naifeh, to recommend to the city council the approval of the ordinance amending the Sapulpa City Code, Part 4, Animals, to provide for exception to the restriction on possessing swine within city limits.

DISCUSS AND CONSIDER RECOMMENDING APPROVAL OF AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING BUSINESS REGISTRATION AND LICENSING FOR ALL BUSINESSES IN THE CITY OF SAPULPA, AND RELATED ISSUES:

City Attorney David Widdoes told the committee he will be drafting an ordinance providing for business registration and licensing for all businesses in the city.
