

**FOURTH PROCLAMATION OF THE CITY OF SAPULPA, OKLAHOMA,
FURTHER DECLARING STATE OF EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2020, and pursuant to the Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, Oklahoma Riot Control and Prevention Act, Section 1321.4, J. Kevin Stitt, Governor of the State of Oklahoma, by Executive Order No. 2020-07, as amended, declared a state of emergency caused by the impending threat of COVID-19 to the people of all 77 counties of the State of Oklahoma and the public's peace, health, and safety; and

WHEREAS, on March 24, 2020, the Governor amended Executive Order 2020-07 requiring vulnerable individuals to stay home except for essential errands, closing non-essential businesses in counties with confirmed cases of COVID-19, suspending certain elective and minor medical procedures, prohibiting gatherings of 10 or more individuals and restricting visitation at nursing homes; and

WHEREAS, on April 22, 2020, the Governor announced the statewide "Open Up and Recover Safely" plan as published by the Oklahoma Department of Commerce ("Reopen Order") providing for a three-phase approach intended to remove and mitigate limitations and restrictions imposed on citizens and businesses as a result of the COVID:19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, Phase 1 of the Reopen Order allows identified businesses the ability to voluntarily reopen on April 24, 2020, and Phase 2 of the Reopen Order allows other identified businesses to reopen on May 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, March 23, 2020 and April 2, 2020, by virtue of the continuing spread of the COVID-19 virus and rising threat to public safety, and pursuant to Part 13 Chapter 4, Sapulpa City Code Sections 13-408-409, Louis Martin Jr, Mayor of the City of Sapulpa, issued three (3) proclamations declaring a state of emergency in the City (collectively "Prior Emergency Proclamations") which impose limitations on public gatherings and business operations in the City to limit social contact and protect the public from additional exposure, illness and death presented by the COVID:19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, additional direction to local residents and businesses operating in Sapulpa following the Governor's announcement of the statewide Reopen Order, will assist our community in having an appropriate response to this continuing threat to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, the Sapulpa City Code, Part 13, Public Safety, Chapter 4, Civil Emergency Management, gives the Mayor the authority to enact and enforce such rules, orders and regulations as deemed necessary for the protection of public health and to prevent the introduction or spread of contagious disease in the City of Sapulpa.

NOW, THEREFORE, BY VIRTUE OF THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME BY THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA AND THE SAPULPA CITY CODE, I, LOUIS MARTIN, JR, MAYOR PRO TEM OF THE CITY OF SAPULPA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM AND DECLARE:

SECTION ONE: The declared state of emergency, as identified in the Prior Emergency Proclamations, is continuing in the City of Sapulpa and constitutes a health emergency as declared by the Governor of the State of Oklahoma.

SECTION TWO: This fourth Proclamation is and shall be effective at 12:01 A.M. April 24, 2020, and shall continue until the date and time of termination of the Governor's declared state of emergency from the COVID:19 pandemic; provided further that this proclamation may be repealed, amended or extended prior to said date and time if assessment of the pandemic so warrants.


SECTION THREE: This fourth Proclamation supersedes the Prior Emergency Proclamations as follows: any provision contained in the Prior Emergency Proclamations that is in actual conflict with the terms and conditions of the Reopen Order is hereby rescinded and

repealed to the extent of actual conflict only. The intent of this fourth Proclamation is to make the terms and provisions of the statewide Reopen Order, as may be amended, effective and operative in the City of Sapulpa until such time as local circumstances warrant the City revising and modifying the same.


SECTION FOUR: Any person violating the orders or restrictions contained in this Proclamation, or violating or causing a business, commercial establishment, or other place of public accommodation to violate this Proclamation, shall be subject to the penalties set forth in the Sapulpa City Code and other applicable state law.
